

## **The Collins Sale.**

John Anderson, Jr., sold Nov. 5 and 6 the private library of the late J. W. R. Collins of Philadelphia. The collection included the many scarce editions of the works of Robert Burns, including the first American edition, and a number of items from Fitz-Greene Halleck's library.

The chief prices were as follows:

Lot 156—Burns's "Poems," Philadelphia, 1788, first American edition, original sheep binding, (name on title page,) \$100.

Lot 339—Fitz-Greene Halleck's scrap-book, containing illustrations, &c., collected between the years 1802-25, \$31.

Lot 385—Document wholly in Lincoln's autograph, dated Sangamon Circuit Court, Feb. 16, 1840, and signed "A. Lincoln," \$51.

Lot 386—Notice to the Clerk of the above court, wholly in Lincoln's handwriting, no date, but about 1840, signed "Stuart and Lincoln," \$22.
